
CIRCULAR

Subject: Enhancing Efficiency of Payment process-reg.

Attention is invited to this office circular of even number dated 06.03.2023 vide which it has been advised that PAOs should strive to reduce the pendency/delays beyond the period stipulated under the revised CAM provision. It may be ensured that bills may be passed within a maximum period of five (05) working days of their receipt in a PAO. The O/o Controller General Accounts is monitoring the position of the pendency of bills at highest level in each Ministry on regular basis.

It is therefore, all the more necessary for the field PAOs to adhere to the revised timeline prescribed in the CAM.
