

It has been brought to the notice of this office by the O/o Pr. CCA, MEA that there is accumulation of outstanding suspense balances in the account of the Ministry of External Affairs due to non-settlement of claims by various Ministries/ Departments/AGs in respect of expenditure made by Indian Missions/Posts abroad on official foreign visits by dignitaries/officials. As per information provided by the Ministry of External Affairs, an amount of Rs. 966.62 crores is due in their books against various Ministries/ Departments/AGs upto 31-03-2022.

2. All Pr. CCAs/CCAs/CAs (with independent charge) are requested to take necessary action for settlement of these pending claims with the Ministry of External Affairs in compliance with para 8.3 of Civil Accounts Manual and intimate the progress in this regard by 15th January, 2023.
